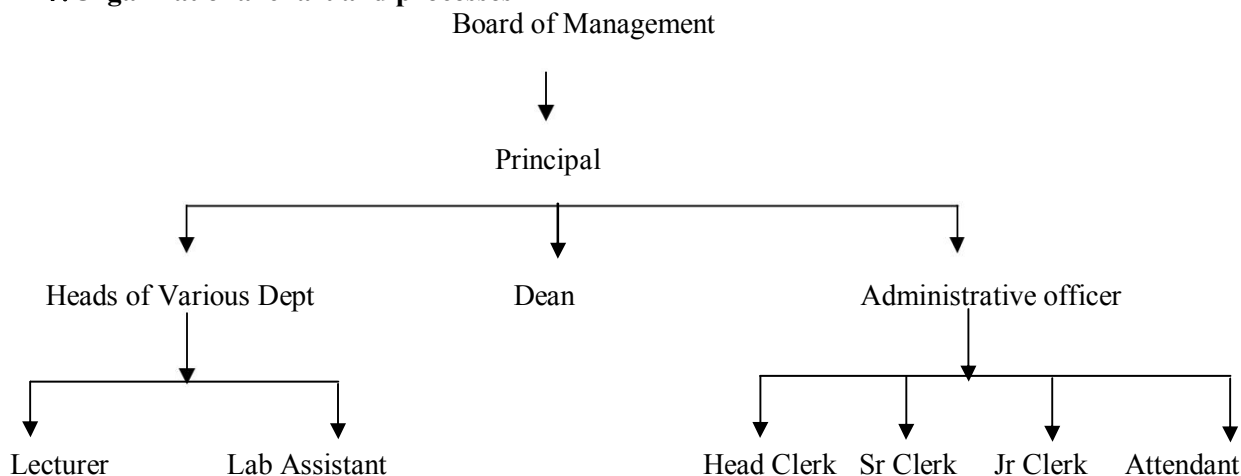

9. Mechanism/ Norms and Procedure for democratic/ good Governance

10. Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/ Faculty performance & Grievance Redressal mechanism for Faculty, staff and students

We have a Manual feedback system for faculty/staff & students. After receiving students' feedback counseling committee reviews the feedback & suggest the possible improvements to the management. Faculty/staff feedbacks/suggestions are directly collected by the principal & necessary actions are taken if required.

11. Establishment of Anti Ragging Committee

College has taken measures in the line of directives of Supreme Court of India in order to prevent ragging. Senior students, faculty and staff have already been counseled regarding implication of any involvement in the act of ragging and consequence thereafter as per provision available in the law. Students have already been advised not to be involved in any act of ragging to avoid any action by civil and police authorities under law based on complaint over toll free numbers of UGC/AICTE/WBCSTE and any other authorities. Newly admitted students have also been advised regarding the act of ragging and they have also advised to report without any reservation, such incident for taking proper care by the college authorities. Anti Ragging Committee also constituted as per provision under norm of AICTE with members from civil and police authorities, NGO, Media, students (Senior and newly admitted) and guardians, faculty and staffs. An Anti-Ragging Squads of faculty and staffs were made for keeping round the clock and strict vigil and devise

various ways and means to be adopted to eliminate Ragging completely. All positive efforts and steps taken and prompt monitoring from all concerned helped in preventing ragging and making the campus as Ragging free.

Course : Diploma in Engineering and Technology

Approved by AICTE, New Delhi, Govt. of India and West Bengal State Council of Technical and Vocational Education and Skill Development, Govt. of West Bengal. **Bengal College of Polytechnic** offers 3Yrs. **Diploma in Engineering and Technology** courses in the following disciplines.

The medium of instruction is ENGLISH. Duration of each discipline is three academic years. Starting session July 2019.

Hostel Facilities: Separately well furnished Boys' and Girls' hostels are available on a first come, first serve basis.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

Citizenship : Must be an Indian Citizen.

Age: Should not be born after **01.07.2006** and there is no upper age limit.

Qualification: Must have passed the Secondary (10th Standard) Examination with English, Physical Science / Science and Mathematics among others as subjects, securing at least 35% marks (without rounding up) in aggregate excluding the marks of the subject taken as additional. The candidates appearing in the Secondary (10th Standard) Examination may also apply. However, confirming that the benchmark of 35% marks (without rounding up) in aggregate excluding the marks of the additional subject is must, failing which candidature is liable to be cancelled even after selection in JEXPO.

Admission through Central Counselling

75 % of approved intake seats of Polytechnic shall be allotted by the Centralized Counselling Systems on the basis of JEXP Rank organized by the West Bengal State Council of Technical and Vocational education and skill Development

Admission under Management Quota

25% of approved intake in each Branch like M.E., C.E, E.E., E.T.C.E, CST etc. shall be admitted directly by the college in the following manners:-

- i) Candidates having any JEXPO Rank possessing aggregate marks in the qualifying exam as stated at sl. no. b) above.
- ii) Candidates without JEXPO Rank but possessing at least 35% Marks (without rounding up) in aggregate excluding the marks of the additional subject is must. Over and above to the marks in aggregate in the qualifying exams as stated at sl. no. b) above.
